

Code of Conduct for Tennis Players

By signing this form you hereby agree to abide by the following Code of Conduct. This sets out a standard of behaviour expected when playing on the tennis courts in order to protect the courts, club, members, non-members and the public.

- 1. All players are required to book a court and pay at the Leisure Centre reception prior to entering the courts.
- 2. Players are responsible for securing the courts at the end of play.
- 3. Non-members will be required to fill out a contact details form before playing (for HSE and insurance purposes).
- 4. Non-marking and clean shoes must be worn.
- 5. Appropriate clothing must be worn. Shirts must be worn at all times.
- 6. No food or alcohol to be taken on the courts.
- 7. No smoking permitted anywhere in the courts or hut.
- 8. No bicycles or other equipment to be taken onto, or used on the courts.
- 9. Players must be familiar with the rules of tennis and make every effort to comply with them.
- 10. Players must conduct themselves in a correct and sportsmanlike manner, respecting the rights of others and behaving with dignity on court at all times.
- 11. At no time must balls or rackets be hit/thrown dangerously or in anger.
- 12. Players must not abuse, neglect, harm or discriminate against anyone; or act in a way that may be interpreted as such. Any issues should be reported to the club Welfare Officer contact details are displayed in the Leisure Centre. All matters will be dealt with confidentially.
- 13. Any accidents/injuries must be reported to the Leisure Centre. An Accident Report form must be filled in (available in the hut and Leisure Centre) and handed to the Leisure Centre reception.
- 14. Players are expected to comply with the above and respect the courts and environs. Any damage or faulty equipment must be reported to the Leisure Centre reception.

Note: The Harleston Tennis & Squash Club Committee has the right to ban players from the club if players do not adhere to the Code of Conduct and/or unwelcome behaviour or damage has occurred. They also have the right to charge members and non-members for any malicious damage.
